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"Phantom Bite"/Occlusal Dysesthesia

Patients sometimes present to their dentists with complaints that "my bite is off," or "I don't know how my teeth are supposed to fit together anymore." This complaint often begins after a restorative procedure, yet is not resolved after attempts by the dentist to adjust the occlusion. This condition has been called "occlusal dysesthesia" or "phantom bite," among other things.
