Secondary Caries, We All Have to Deal With it!

According to our recent April 2017 Quick Poll, secondary caries is still an important reason for restoration failure and restoration replacement. About a third of our respondents indicated that between 50 to 75% of the restorations that they replaced are due to secondary caries. Another third specified that it happened between 25 and 50% of their cases. Meanwhile less than a quarter of the respondents mentioned that replacements due to secondary caries only occurred in less than 25% of the cases.. [Read more...](#)
