National Dental PBRN Study News

Studies Currently Underway:



1. Cracked Tooth Registry

- 4-year observational study of 3,000 cracked teeth nationally
- Identify characteristics predictive of adverse outcomes
- 40 Southwest practitioners currently enrolling patients

2. Predicting Successful Crowns - Part 1

- Questionnaire to assess crown preparation techniques, impression materials and methods
- 250 Southwest dentists will be invited to participate via email over the next few months

3. Management of Dentin Hypersensitivity

- Comparative effectiveness study of treatments in use
- Pilot underway, 30 Southwest dentists will participate in main phase of study

4. Decision Aids for the Management of Suspicious Occlusal Caries Lesions (SOCL)

- Investigate the utility of Spectra and Diagodent in dentists' decision making processes towards SOCLs
- Pilot underway, 17 Southwest dentists will participate in main phase of study

- Prospective, observational, 3-year cohort study of adults receiving orthodontic treatment for anterior openbite
- Aims to estimate the proportion of patients treated successfully
- Looking for 35 orthodontists from the Southwest Region to participate

- Determine rates and risk factors for persistent oral HPV infection
- Screen for precancerous lesions among persons with infection
