Making a Good First Impression

When a patient needs a crown, most dentists create a polymeric impression of the tooth, create a stone cast from the impression, and have a laboratory make a crown from the cast. But the impressions laboratories receive are sometimes flawed, and dentists have to redo them. A new study shows what factors are associated with making a good impression on the first try, researchers reported in the November 2017 *Journal of the American Dental Association*. Read more...



Quick Poll Results: Dentists Weigh In on Incomplete Caries Removal

Most dentists will leave some infected tissue before doing a restoration when they think removing it would expose the pulp, our November Quick Poll shows. Of the 400 poll respondents, 76 percent said they had done an incomplete caries removal. This reverses a long-standing practice in dentistry of removing all bacteria and infected dental tissues before restoring the resulting cavity. Read more...
