



HealthPartners Institute, Bloomington, Minnesota is **seeking dentists and dental hygienists who wish to participate in a research study**. The purpose of the research is to examine the effect of a smart tool integrated into the Dentrix, EagleSoft or Open Dental electronic dental record in your clinic.

You may be eligible if:

- You are a practicing dental hygienist, dental therapist, or dentist.
- You estimate treating on average each week ≥3 patients who currently smoke.
- You use Dentrix 6.6 (or better), EagleSoft 19.2 (or better) or Open Dental 16 (or better) for patient care.
- You can complete a web-based questionnaire at baseline and again when the study is completed.

The smart tool generates evidence-based provider messages to assist you in helping patients with tobacco cessation. Messages are personalized for patients' current smoking status and interest in quitting. Clinics will be randomized into 2 study arms: the intervention arm (usual care + smart tool available) or control arm (usual care, no smart tool).

Patient smokers who authorize contact may be surveyed by HealthPartners phone interviewers about any actions they've made toward quitting within one week of their dental visit and again at 6 months.

Projected study launch: Spring 2019

Compensation:

Each enrolled provider will receive \$50 and each clinic will receive \$100 upon completion of the study.
