

The conference will include a rich scientific program delivered by world-renowned speakers, Robert Convissar, DDS, and Praveen Arany, DDS, PhD. Read more...



Dental Network Has High Rate of Participation

If you build a network, dental professionals will participate, a study of National Dental PBRN participation rates showed. The study sample found that a large percentage of National Dental PBRN members participated in at least one Network activity between 2005, when the Network began, and 2017. The study was published in the November-December 2018 Journal of the American Board of Family Medicine: JABFM.


The study found high rates of sustained participation among enrolled members. "Strategies employed by the network to engage practitioners may serve as a model for PBRN networks for other allied health professions," the authors wrote. Read more...
