

Best Approach for Questionable Caries? Monitoring, Study Shows

When a tooth has signs of caries-roughness, surface opacities, or staining-but a radiograph shows no evidence of caries, clinicians should consider long-term monitoring as their management approach, a Network study in the November 2014 Journal of the American Dental Association (JADA) showed. Invasive procedures on these so-called questionable occlusal caries (QOCs) aren't recommended, the authors stated. Read more...
