Members discussed their questions and shared prior experience with practice-based research on "How will a National Dental PBRN study fit into your practice?"

- Establish a process that works in your office, each office will have their own unique process
- Training is important!
- Educate your staff about the goals of the National Dental PBRN and the studies

Members compiled a list of unanswered questions in the literature that could become research questions addressed by the network. Sixteen study ideas were generated, including questions on:

- Restorative Dentistry/Prosthodontics
- Periodontics
- Hygiene
- Practice Management/patient management
- Dental/medical connection
- Oral surgery
- Fluoride products
- Whitening products
- New products/procedures evaluation
- Sleep apnea
- Caries risk assessment
- Implants
- Dentures
- Pain management
