### [Juvenile Idiopathic Arthritis \(JIA\)](#)

JIA is one of the most common chronic joint diseases in childhood and represents a series of chronic inflammatory arthritis that develop before the age of 16 years. It normally persists for at least 6 weeks and has no identifiable cause and is significantly distinct from adult rheumatoid arthritis. JIA has been shown to affect up to 150 in 100,000 children around the globe and has a significant debilitating effect on these young children. Depending on the subtype, TMJ involvement may occur in 17% to 87% and is often dependent on diagnostic criteria and ethnicity.
