Juvenile Idiopathic Arthritis

There is little understanding of the orthodontic management of Temporomandibular Joint (TMJ) arthritis in children in the United States and certainly less consensus on a global scale. Juvenile Idiopathic Arthritis is one of the most common chronic joint diseases in childhood and represents a series of chronic inflammatory arthritides that develop before the age of 16 years. It normally persists for at least 6 weeks, has no identifiable cause, and is significantly distinct from adult rheumatoid arthritis. JIA has been shown to affect up to 150 in 100,000 children around the globe and has a significant debilitating effect on these young children. Read more...
