The network recently received funding to conduct a study about the **impact of COVID-19 on dental practice**. Its purpose is to identify and evaluate information about effective approaches used by practitioners to mitigate COVID-19 transmission risks, costs, and practitioners' comfort levels with these approaches. This will be the largest study the network will have conducted, involving upwards of a few thousand practitioners. The network will hold learning webinars to share the results.

Network Publication of the Month

Practitioner Engagement in Activities of the National Dental PBRN: 7-year Results

Network investigators conducted a retrospective analysis of 4,361 practitioners enrolled in the network between 2012 and 2018. They quantified practitioner activities, such as Continuing Education credits received and participation in publication, presentation, and meeting activities. They concluded that practitioners participated in a broad range of activities, which were successful in sustaining a high level of practitioner engagement in clinical research and its relevance to everyday clinical practice.
