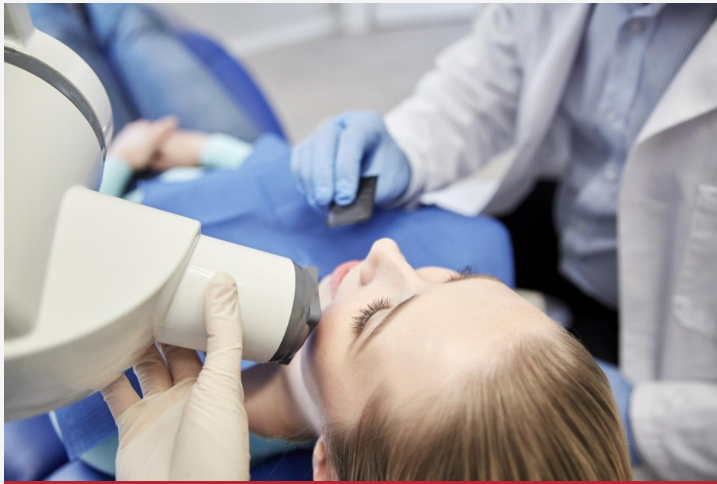




Radiation Safety
